

Figurative Destruction: An Exhibition by Wulf Treu

Figurative Destruction is a new exhibition from the acclaimed artist, Wulf Treu, coinciding with the Frieze Art Fair on Randall's Island. This Quin Arts exhibition features dramatic large format oil paintings on canvas, mixed media works on wood, and a video art wall installation highlighting the artist's neon works. For the first time, Treu presents studies on paper from his body of work in sculpture, painting, and mixed media. These studies are grouped into five stories, each containing four original oil, pastel, pencil and watercolor works, affording collectors and guests a special opportunity to acquire Treu's work at an unprecedented price point. Framed with offset primary colors, each piece is signed, dated and embossed by the artist.
